Proposed change to recommendations to aid clarity:

Item 5: Merseyside and Halton Joint Waste Local Plan: Adoption of Plan

A. Proposed change to recommendations to aid clarity:

Recommendations

That Planning Committee and Cabinet

- (i) note the results of public consultation on the proposed modifications to the Merseyside and Halton Joint Waste Local Plan which was undertaken between November 2012 and January 2013
- (ii) welcome the report from the Planning Inspector which concluded that, subject to the proposed modifications, the Plan “meets the criteria for soundness in the National Planning Policy Framework” and “provides an appropriate basis for waste planning for Merseyside and Halton over the next 15 years”
- (iii) note that several of the Sefton Unitary Development Plan policies will be replaced by Waste Local Plan policies including the site allocations
- (iv) recommend that Council consider the Waste Local Plan for adoption.

That Council

- (v) agrees to delegate powers to the Head of Planning Services to make necessary minor typographical changes to the Waste Local Plan prior to its final publication.
- (vi) agrees to adopt the Waste Local Plan as part of the statutory development plan and in so doing note that the adoption is contingent upon all other Merseyside Councils and Halton Council also adopting the plan as set out in Section 3 of the report.

Should all Council proceed to adopt the Waste Local Plan this will take effect on 18 July 2013. Should all Councils for whatever reason not proceed to adopt the plan, then Council will be advised accordingly.
