Background

Why a Cloud First Strategy?

- Sefton's ICT Infrastructure is aging and requires significant investment to ensure it can scale up to meet increasing demands for ICT resource and capacity.
- Current arrangements for Business Continuity at Southport are limited and are based on equipment which is also end of life
- We have ambitions to create a flexible, agile and cost effective platform that will underpin a number of business outcomes over the next few years, including the Corporate Property Strategy
- In light of the radical change in the way we work as an authority there is a clear need to have an agile,
 flexible infrastructure that supports remote working, access to data and collaborative working through
 greater use of digital technology

Running Cost PA

- Over a 5-year budget the predicated TCO is set to reduce by 1.7m
- Running costs do increase from year 4 however this needs to be set against the investment needed every 5 years for a total infrastructure refresh, which results in the overall saving (as included within cost avoidance)
- Ongoing programme of optimization established to reduce un-necessary spend



Once migration is completed the following work will be completed, starting June 22

- Decommissioning and right sizing of the remaining on-premise estate
 - The removal of legacy applications no longer in use
 - Planning the decommissioning of legacy applications in line with the implementation and deployment of new solutions such as telephony
 - $^{\infty}$ The rationalisation of the remaining applications onto a smaller server footprint
- It is also necessary to align the forward plan for procurement to those applications that cannot currently be moved to Cloud

The above work will inform the final sizing of the new Data Centre at Bootle Town Hall and any further local investment requirement for business continuity (linked to the remaining applications due to go through procurement)
