Late comments have been received from Merseyside's Police, Designing Out Crime Officer. They indicate that the level of crime in the area is high and any looked after children would be at risk of involvement in antisocial behaviour. However, they go on to suggest that it is expected that the proposed children's home would have suitable safeguarding management strategy and internal policies in place to fully support vulnerable residents and to reduce the risk and subject to such measures would have no objection to the proposed development.

Following a request from environmental health, the following condition has been added to limit the number of children cared for within the home to 2.

5. The children's home shall be occupied by no more than 2 children at any one time. This shall remain the case for the life of the development.

Reason: To safeguard the living conditions of neighbouring occupiers and land users.
