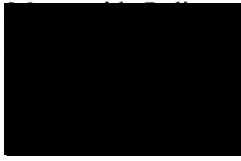

This review application is made based on the premises undermining the licensing objective of Prevention of Crime and Disorder and Public Safety.

Merseyside Police have serious concerns in relation to the management of the venue stemming from the below reported incident.

The current Premises Licence Holder of the venue is Mr Gary Joseph Shields.

On the 29th October 2021 at 2359hrs a call was received via the 999 system advising that there was a fight ongoing and the informant's boyfriend was punched twice to the head. Officers attended the area in the early hours of the 30th October and after speaking to the informant who was no longer present at the venue, attended at Gambino's Bar. The shutters were down and an officer has walked towards the rear gate where a male has walked out of the venue. It is known that this male was [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] was subsequently searched by the officer and a knuckle duster was located in his left jeans pocket. [REDACTED] was arrested for Possession of an offensive weapon. [REDACTED] was taken to a police custody suite where his detention was authorised. [REDACTED] was subsequently interviewed and charged with the offence.

Enquiries at the venue were conducted and CCTV was obtained of the incident. During these enquiries it was evident that the venue was breaching a number of the premises licence annex 2 conditions. It was also established that the venue had committed further offences under Section 136 of the Licensing Act 2003 namely the unauthorised sale of alcohol.

It is clear to the police that there are serious concerns surrounding the management of the venue, and they have clearly failed in promoting / upholding the licensing objectives. Merseyside Police would therefore request that the venue is subject to review proceedings.
