The CCG is recording a dementia diagnosis rate of 59.3%, which is under the national dementia diagnosis ambition of 66.7%. month's performance The CCG approved a scheme to go into 2021/22 Local Quality Contract with primary care across Sefton to support access to the memory clinics.

In line with a Cheshire & Merseyside system approach to improving Memory Assessment waits Mersey Care NHS Foundation Trust have established memory weekend clinics with intention of continuing the clinics until the end of March 2022.

Age Concern (Liverpool and Sefton)

A dedicated memory service operates at the Hesketh Centre, Southport. Memory services in South Sefton operate from Waterloo Day Hospital.

The memory assessment service aids in the early detection and diagnosis of dementia. The service is for both older people and those of working age who are experiencing memory problems.

Mersey Care NHS Trust – Inpatient Service – Elm Ward Aintree and Boothroyd Unit Southport Provides an acute assessment service for people with an organic mental health problem including dementia.
