1.1 A petition has been received containing 82 signatures of residents of 48 properties in Ferndale Road. The petition states:

"I / we confirm that I / we fully support the introduction of a Residents Only Parking Scheme on Ferndale Road, Waterloo."

1.2 Members are reminded that the policy for the introduction of new waiting restrictions (including Residents Privileged Parking Schemes) approved by the Cabinet Member – Locality Services, indicates the following:

Waiting restrictions will not be progressed: -

- To remove or displace parking by non-residents outside residential
 properties unless carried out as part of a Planning Condition and funded by
 a developer or promoted by Ward Members' and funded by Ward budgets.
 All new schemes promoted by Ward Members will be progressed in strict
 chronological order, as quickly as remaining staff resources allow.
- At locations where former RPP schemes have been removed following consultation with residents.
- 1.3 In view of the above it is suggested that Officers consult with Ward Members regarding the request and then a response be made to the lead petitioner.
