(5) It be noted that the proposal was a Key Decision but had not been included in the Council's Forward Plan of Key Decisions. Consequently, the Leader of the Council and the Chair of the Overview and Scrutiny Committee (Adult Social Care and Health) had been consulted under Rule 27 of the Access to Information Procedure Rules of the Constitution, to the decision being made by Cabinet as a matter of urgency on the basis that it was impracticable to defer the decision until the commencement of the next Forward Plan because the Cabinet had requested a further report on Supported Living and Day Care Fees.

The report is following Cabinet meeting on 25th May 2023 where Cabinet requested a further review of Supported Living and Day Care rates.

This work has been completed (including benchmarking work) and has resulted in the revised proposals in this report.

Due to the revised recommendation to increase Supported Living fee rates by 12.83% then the report recommends that this same increase is awarded to Extra Care Housing and Individual Service Fund services due to the similar nature of these services, and therefore represents a change to the rates proposed to Cabinet on 25th May 2023.
