**Re: Application for a new premises licence: 3-5 Altway Liverpool L10 3JA**

I wish to register my opposition to the to this proposed general convenience store, also selling alcohol.

The location is well supplied with convenience shops, including a Tesco Local (open until 11.00 each day), a PRM store opposite Old Roan Station, Morrisons Local in Altway and ASDA (open 24 hours, apart from Sundays). All these stores provide a wide range of convenience goods and services and are licenced to sell alcohol.

It seems ridiculous to have yet another such store. And I am concerned that its being open until 00.00 will attract individuals and groups who are likely to create late-night noise and nuisance, especially for those residents in the flats above, and nearby to these premises. I am also concerned that a delivery service operating between 00.00 and 03.00 will increase the level of disturbance to residents.

Re: NOTICE IS GIVEN that NEK Trading LTD have applied to Sefton Metropolitan Borough Council for a new premises licence at 3 - 5 Altway, Aintree, L10 3JA for;

The sale of alcohol for consumption off the premises 0700 to 0300 hours daily - the shop will close at 0000 hours and then take orders (for delivery only) until 0300 hours.

Late night refreshment to 0300 hours - the shop will close at 0000 hours and then take orders (for delivery only) until 0300 hours

The shop will become a new general convenience store selling a wide range of goods.

As residents of [REDACTED] [REDACTED] for 47 years this month we wish to appeal against the application of Nek Ltd for the property 3-5 Altway to become a general store selling liquor and takeaways of food and liquor up to 0300 hours (3am).

There are already other premises selling liquor nearby or only a few minutes away and most are open until late at night. Tesco express is opposite the proposed site and open until 11pm. At the other end of the village Bargain Booze already have a takeaway using Uber, whilst Morrisons local sell alcohol till late. Asda only a few minutes drive away is open 24 hours except on a Sunday. Other stores in the area offer Uber deliveries throughout the night. How many more do we need?

The issuing of a license for it to stay open until 3am for 'deliveries' is unfair on residents who live above or near. As the road leading to the proposed shop is a one way drive residents of Ormskirk Road, Oundle Avenue ( side and backs of houses) and Bradfield Avenue would be affected by delivery vehicles coming and going throughout the night .

Recent events outside the premises proves it is already a congregating area for drug dealers. A car deliberately ramming two bikers. Large police attendance witnessed by my husband on his evening walk to the pillar box! Eye witnesses say it was probably drug related. It could also encourage more gangs of mainly young males to congregate there later at night. Around the same time a young man was shot and died nearby.

We are also concerned that if they take away custom from Tesco we may lose this shop as much of Tesco's evening business is for drinks and snacks.

Extra litter would also be generated.

We in [REDACTED] [REDACTED] already get disturbed at times with cars or motorbikes racing round the village late at night.

.We are an elderly couple who only recently had our front door damaged by passing (drug/alcohol fuelled persons?) kicking our front door and running away. Please think of our neighbourhood when you make your decision. We are a residential village and do not need more shops selling alcohol especially at night! 11pm is late enough and there are many alternatives available for home delivery if you google them.

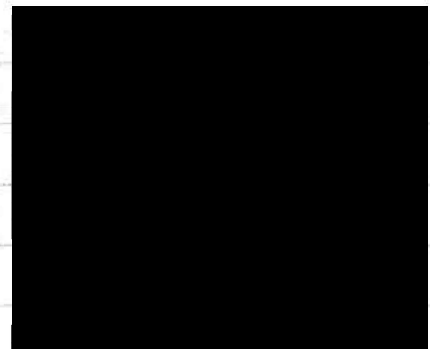

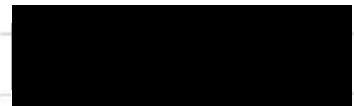
