The Cabinet of Sefton Metropolitan Borough Council intends to hold a meeting (or parts thereof), on the date shown above, in private.

The following exempt issue will be considered:

## Procurement of Fully Integrated Community Domestic Abuse Service (Part exempt)

Sefton is seeking to procure a fully Integrated Domestic Abuse Service (IDAS) from 2025 for a minimum of 3 years. The service will provide holistic support to the victims and families of domestic abuse, irrespective of protected characteristic or risk level. The service will provide therapeutic counselling to those that require it in order to build resilience and aid recovery from the long-term effects of domestic abuse. The service will address a number of the priorities outlined in the action plan accompanying the Domestic and Sexual Abuse Strategy 2023-2028.

It is proposed to exclude the public from this item of business on the grounds that it is likely to disclose exempt information, as defined in the following paragraph of Part 1 of Schedule 12A to the Local Government Act 1972:

3. Information relating to the financial or business affairs of any particular person (including the authority holding that information)
