In accordance with the Council's Petition Scheme set out in Chapter 12 of the Council Constitution, the following public petitions have been submitted for consideration at the Council meeting.

The lead petitioner for each of the petition deputations will be given five minutes to present their petition at the Council meeting and the petition will then be discussed by Councillors for a maximum of 15 minutes each. The Council will decide how to respond to the petitions at the meeting and the lead petitioners will receive written confirmation of the decision.

Southport Market/Market Street Proposals
The petition containing 560 signatures has been submitted by Mr Ray Owens of Haydock, St Helens which states:
"We the undersigned believe there should be improved measures undertaken at Southport Market/Market Street for both existing and new tenants on the grounds of improving the local economy and for our local community neighbourhood here."
Trafalgar Road Area Proposals – Car Parking
The petition containing 512 signatures has been submitted by Mr Eric Beninson of Birkdale, Southport which states:
"We the undersigned believe there should be improved measures undertaken at the Trafalgar Road Area, namely the Smedley Hydropathic Centre for both existing and new neighbours and stakeholders on the grounds of improving and maintaining peaceful and harmonious relations between all members of the local Community."
