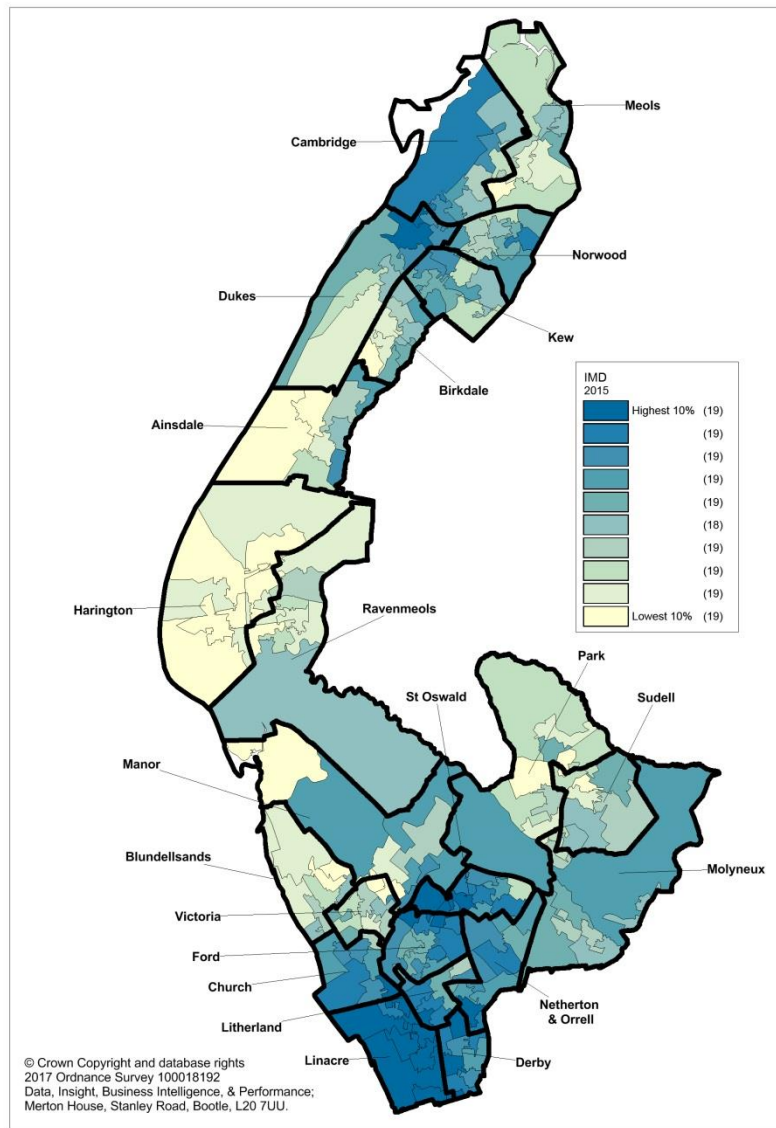

Index of Multiple Deprivation

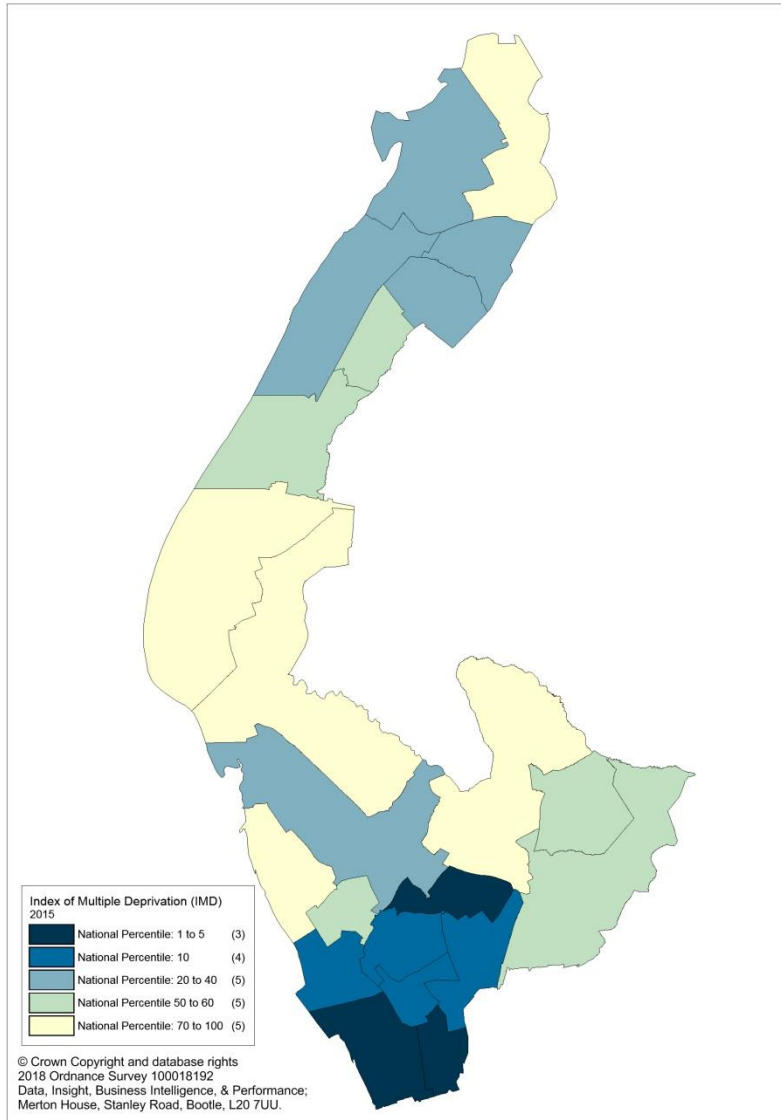


7 IMD domain indices:

1. **Income** - the proportions of the population experiencing income deprivation in an area.
2. **Employment** - people of working age who are involuntarily excluded from the world of work, either through unemployment, ill health or family circumstances.
3. **Health and disability** - areas with relatively high rates of people who die prematurely or whose quality of life is impaired by poor health or who are disabled, across the whole population.
4. **Education, skills and training** - lack of attainment among children and young people and lack of qualifications in terms of skills.
5. **Barriers to Housing and Services** - 'geographical barriers' and 'wider barriers' which includes issues relating to access to housing such as affordability.
6. **Living environment** - the 'indoors' living environment which measures the quality of housing and the 'outdoors' living environment which contains two measures about air quality and road traffic accidents.
7. **Crime** - the rate of recorded crime for four major crime themes of burglary, theft, criminal damage and violence.

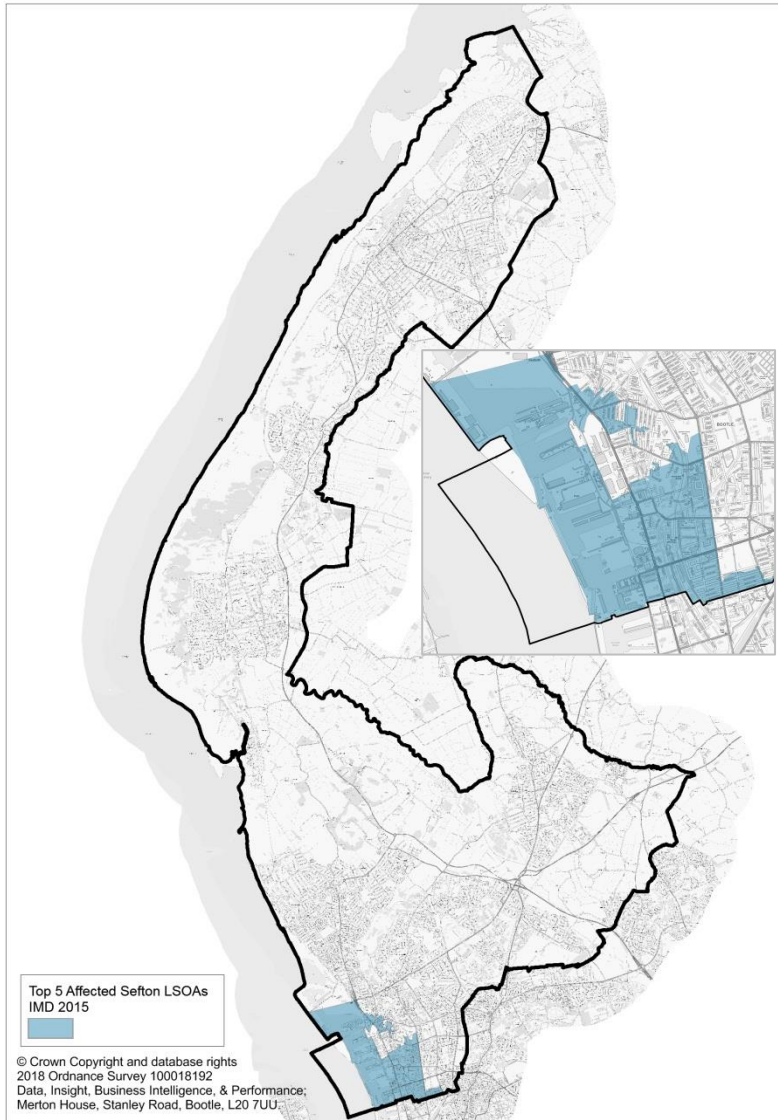
