Achievements

- Grade 2 Good Ofsted provider
- Over 2000 learner annually
- Matrix accredited
- 35 fully qualified tutors
- 183 learners recruited for qualifications
- 96% of learners achieved their course
- 92.3% of tutors observed were deemed to be good or better teaching grades (27 tutors)
- 97% of learners said they would recommend the Service to others
- 8.6% of learners surveyed gained employment (responses 638)
- 100% of learners completing GCSE qualifications passed

What next in 2018/19

- SCLS being recognised as a Google Centre
- Google classrooms being utilised in some subject areas
- Learners on every course being able to access and use IT
- Extended use of video conferencing to communicate with subcontractors and tutors
