1. <u>Proposed Schools Forum Representation 2018/190</u>

- 1.1 There have been some changes to the required representation of Schools forum due to there now being primary academies in Sefton.
- 1.2 It is proposed to follow the model adopted for secondary representatives and base Forum representation on the proportion of schools in each phase. This gives 3 secondary academy reps and 2 maintained secondary reps (actual ratio 3.35 to 1.75) and 1 primary academy rep and 4 maintained primary reps (actual ratio 0.25 to 4.75)
- 1.3 It is proposed that other representation remains the same.

2. <u>Proposed Forum Membership 2018/19</u>

2.1 The local authority has been notified of one resignation to Schools Forum but no other proposed changes have been put forward. The attached membership proposal for 2018/19 has been put together based on membership last academic year. It reflects the move of one primary headteacher and governor member becoming the primary academy representatives.
