## <u>CONSTITUTION - RULE 29 OF THE ACCESS TO</u> INFORMATION PROCEDURE RULES (SPECIAL URGENCY)

This memorandum is to confirm that I have been consulted by the Deputy Leader of the Council (Councillor Fairclough) under Rule 29 of the Access to Information Procedure Rules of the Constitution to the following issue:-

Approval for the termination of the current CCS Gas framework and subsequent appointment to the NEPO Gas Framework for a two year interim contract, in order to secure early financial savings.

being dealt with by the Cabinet as a matter of urgency on the basis that it is impracticable to defer the decision because the contract must be terminated before 17<sup>th</sup> September 2019 under our current contract rules. Subsequent prices will also be subject to market forces and we wish to secure prices early to achieve a financial saving for the council, schools and partners on our energy portfolio.

Options for remaining within the CCS framework were withdrawn on 2 September 2019, which necessitated this action, to secure current prices.
